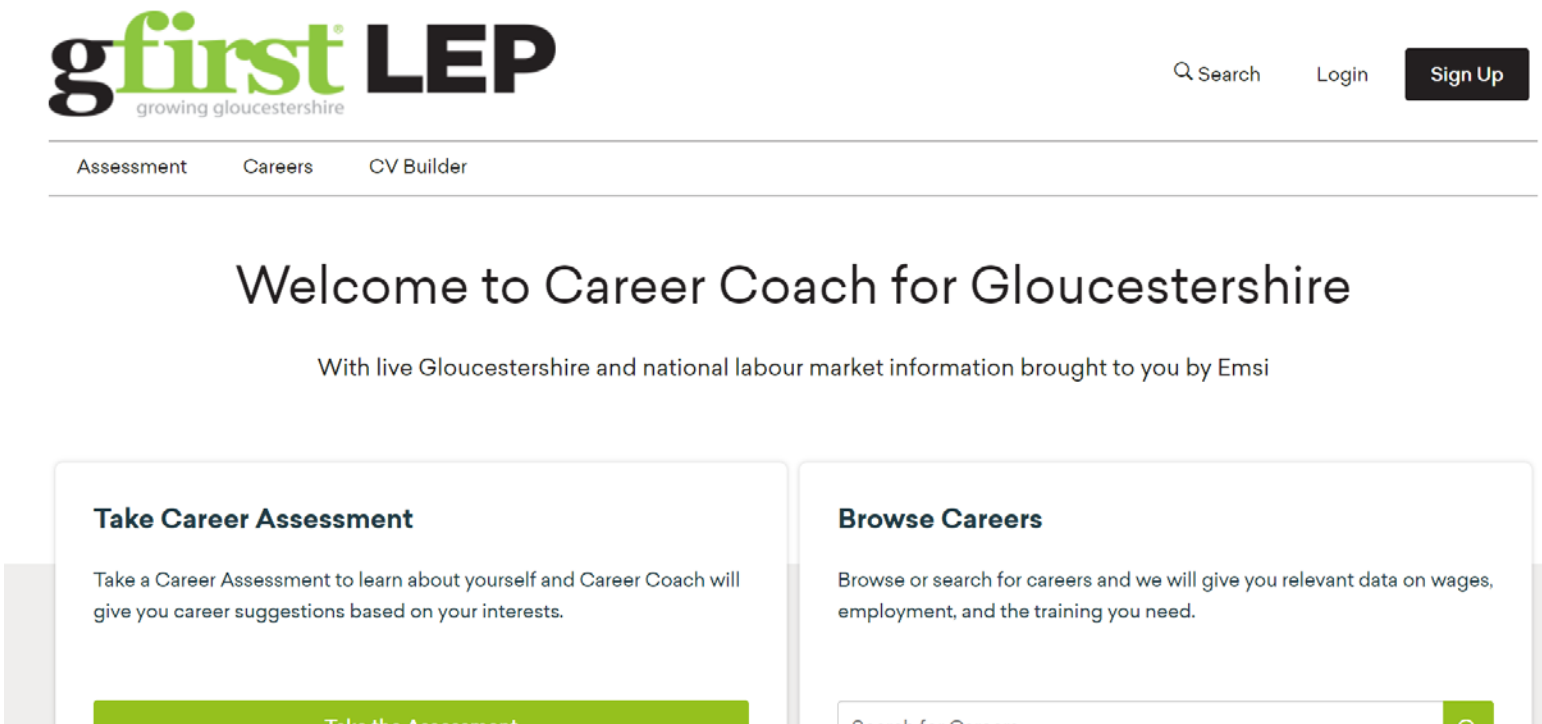

Headlines from November 2021 figures



- The Claimant Count in Gloucestershire decreased by 360 persons to 11,690 and the rate has gone down to 3.0%
- Job posting numbers for the month of November were around 54,875 which is an increase of around 5,891 job postings when compared to October
- Final confirmed figures show there were a total of 8,500 employments furloughed in Gloucestershire as at the 30th September, with 3,210 being in the 45 to 59 age bracket
- To date Gloucestershire has seen a cumulative total of 113,500 employments supported by the Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme at various times



EMSI job posting numbers



- Job posting numbers for the month of November 2021 were around 54,875 which is an increase of around 5,981 job postings when compared to updated October 2021 figure of 48,894. Please note that the October figure has been revised upwards in the latest EMSI job posting data run.
- Chart 1 gives a district overview of total job postings for the month of November, comparing the same month in 2019, 2020 and 2021.
- The number of jobs posted in November 2021 exceeds the same month for previous years in all six districts.

* Please note - a data quality issue has been identified which means previously some jobs outside of the county have been included in the Gloucestershire figures. This issue does not appear to have affected the overall trends but does mean previously circulated numbers may have overestimated the number of job postings in the county.

The October job posting figure has been revised upwards to 48,894 in the latest EMSI job posting data run.

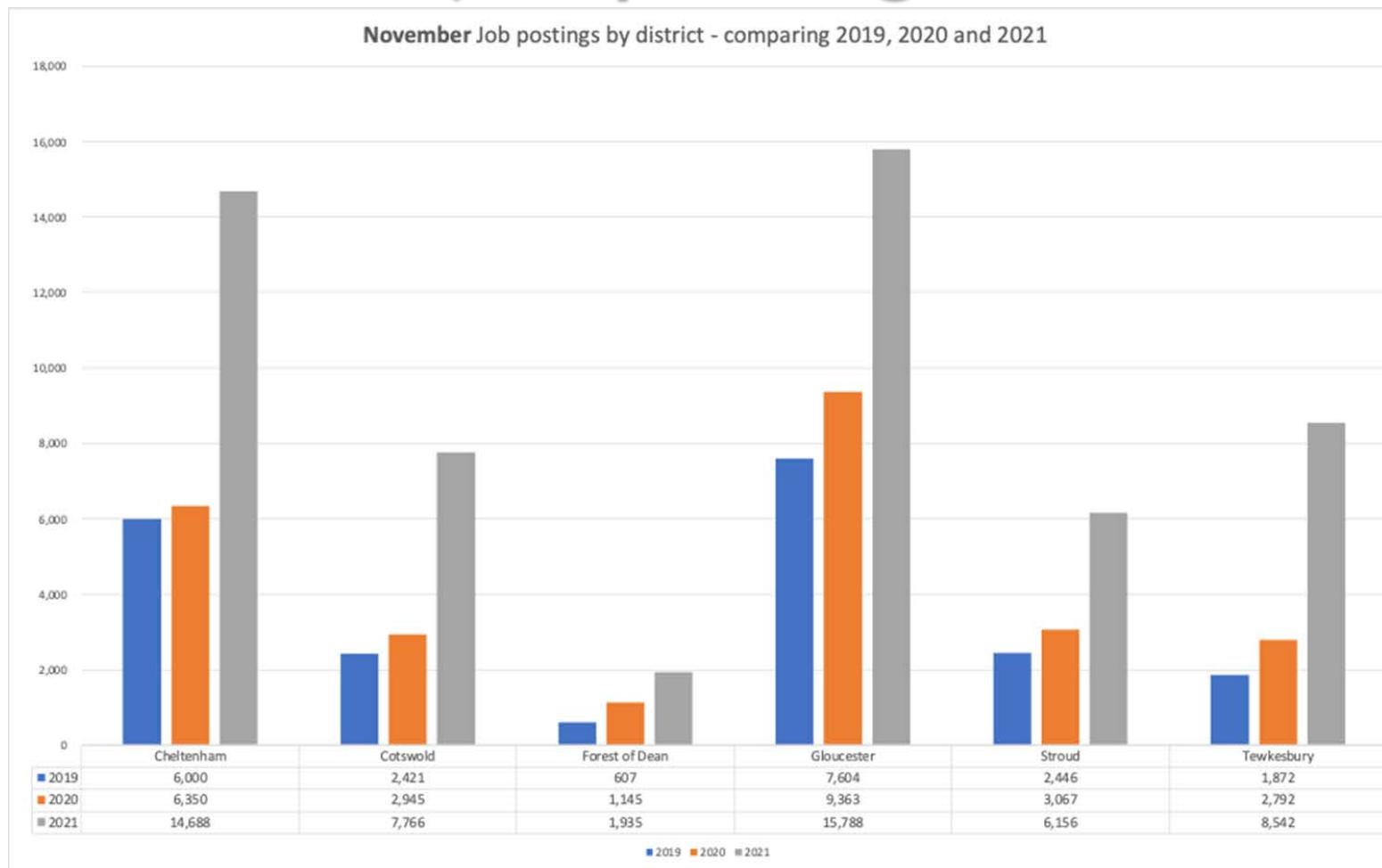


Chart 1: District overview of total jobs in November 2021 when compared with November 2020 and November 2019



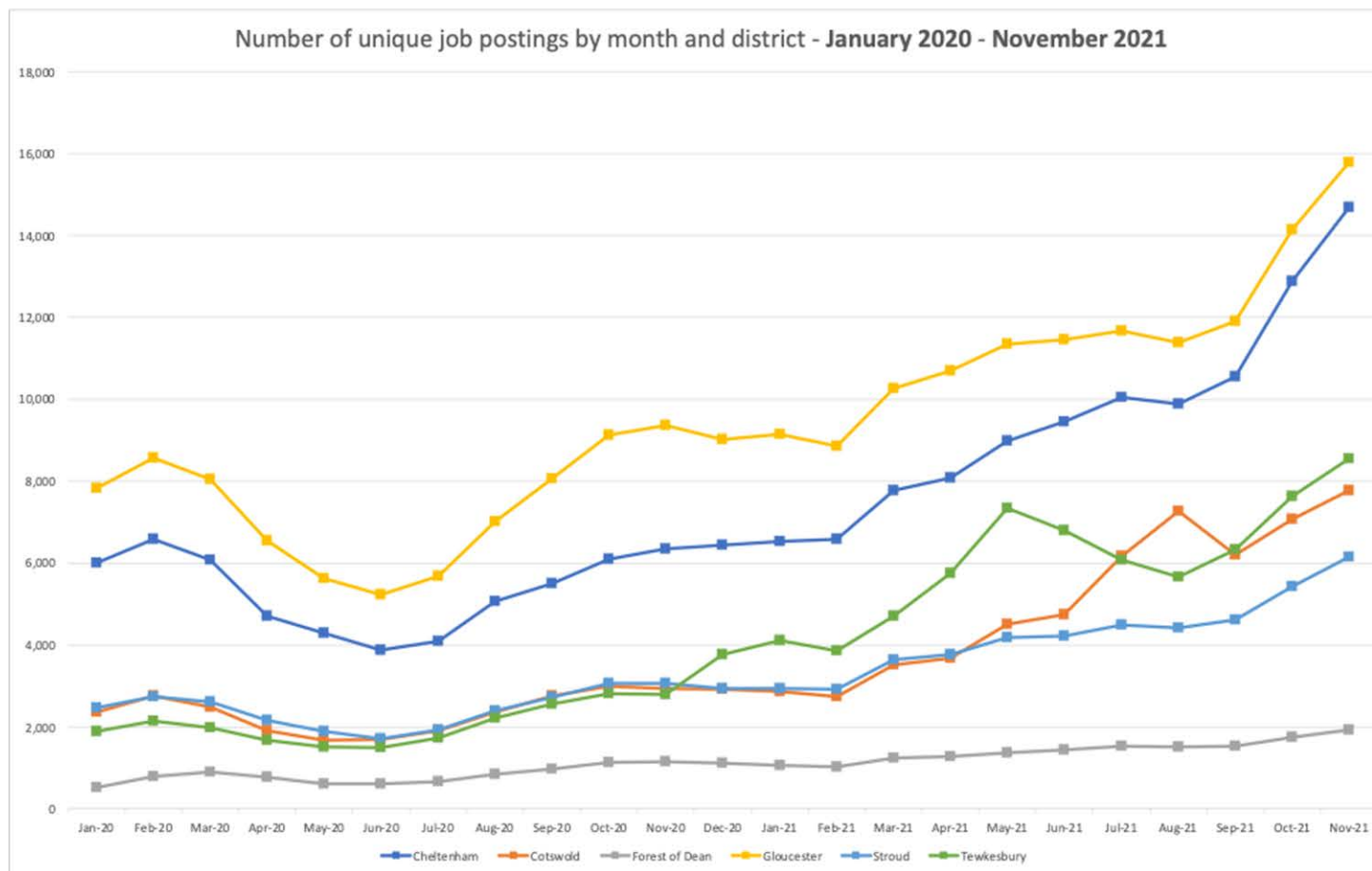

- Chart 2 below shows total jobs by district from January 2019 to November 2021, with most districts displaying a similar trend over the past few months and all seeing an increase when compared to October 2021.

Please note – job posting numbers are based on snapshot data taken on the 9th December, numbers are provisional and subject to change. The information is continually being cleaned and validated, but job posting numbers provide a good indication on how the job market is performing.

EMSI delivers real time access to job vacancies from a comprehensive range of sources including job boards, employer sites, newspapers, public agencies etc. Data extraction and analysis technologies mine and code data from each job listing to provide analysis on industries, occupations, skills and qualifications. However, the tool will inevitably not capture all vacancies.

Types of jobs posted



- Chart 3 below shows the net change in the number of job postings by top level occupation (two-digit SOC), comparing October to November 2021.
- Almost all occupations have seen an increase in November when compared to October, with some large increases seen in Business and Public Service Associate Professionals (723) and Caring Personal Service Occupations (695).

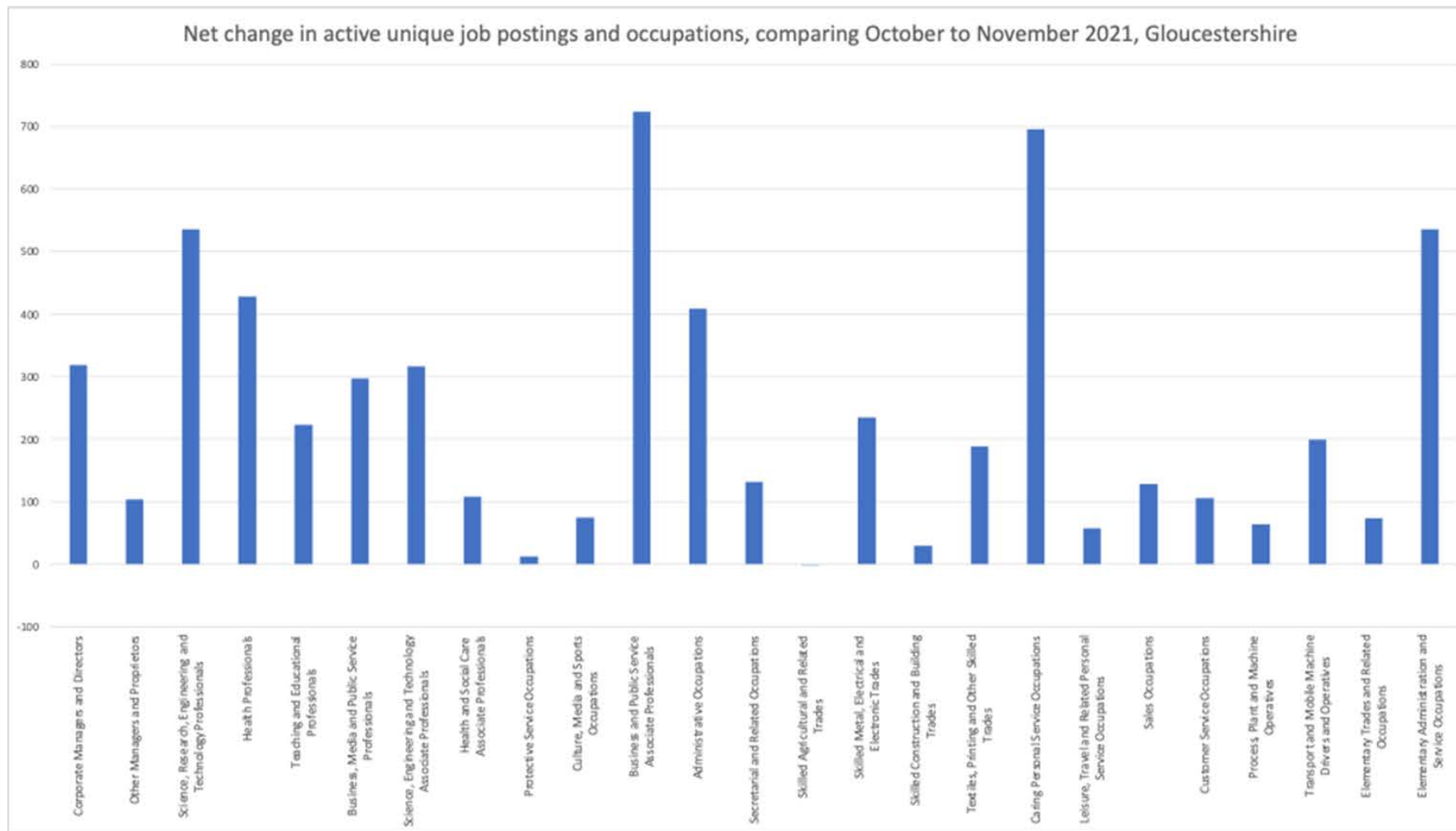


Chart 3: Net change in the number of job postings by two-digit (SOC) code, comparing November 2020 and November 2021.



Top companies posting and skills required (November 2021)



- **The top companies posting jobs in November include;** Gloucestershire Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust, NHS, Gloucestershire Education Department, Gloucestershire Health and Care NHS Foundation Trust and Barchester – please note that we have not included employment agencies in top companies posting, employment agencies do however form part of the total jobs posted in the report.
- **Top posted occupations in November:** Nurses, Care workers and home carers, Programmers and software development professionals, Sales accounts and business development managers, and Elementary Storage Occupations .
- **Top posted job titles** include; Support Workers, Care Assistants, Warehouse Operatives, , Health Care Assistants and Registered Nurses.
- **Top hard skills** listed in job postings include; Finance, Auditing, Agile Methodology, Warehousing and Accounting.
- **Top common skills** listed include; Communications, Management, Customer Service, Sales and Enthusiasm.



November Claimant Count



- December saw the publication of the November **Claimant Count figures: the Gloucestershire figure has gone down to 3.0% (the value is expressed as a proportion of residents aged 16-64). The November total now stands at 11,690 compared to the October figure of 12,050 which is a monthly decrease of 360 persons. All districts saw a decrease in the number of claimants.
- The November figure for the South West was 3.3%, England was 4.7% and the UK figure was 4.6%.

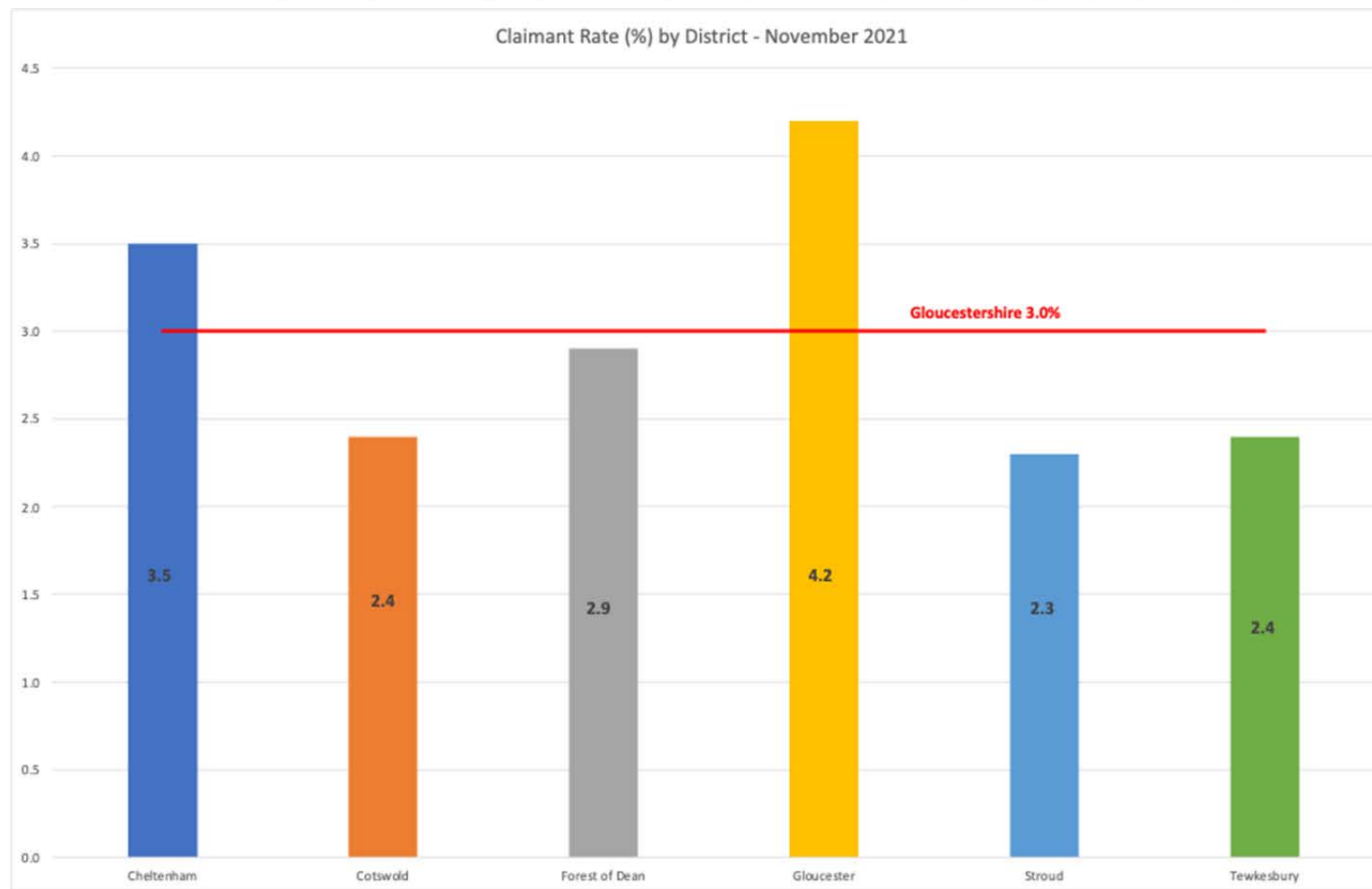


Chart 4: Claimant rate for November 2021 in Gloucestershire

- Chart 5 shows the current claimant rate for Gloucestershire at 3.0%, when compared with all six districts, the South West and England.
- The rate for Gloucestershire continues to be below that of England and the South West.

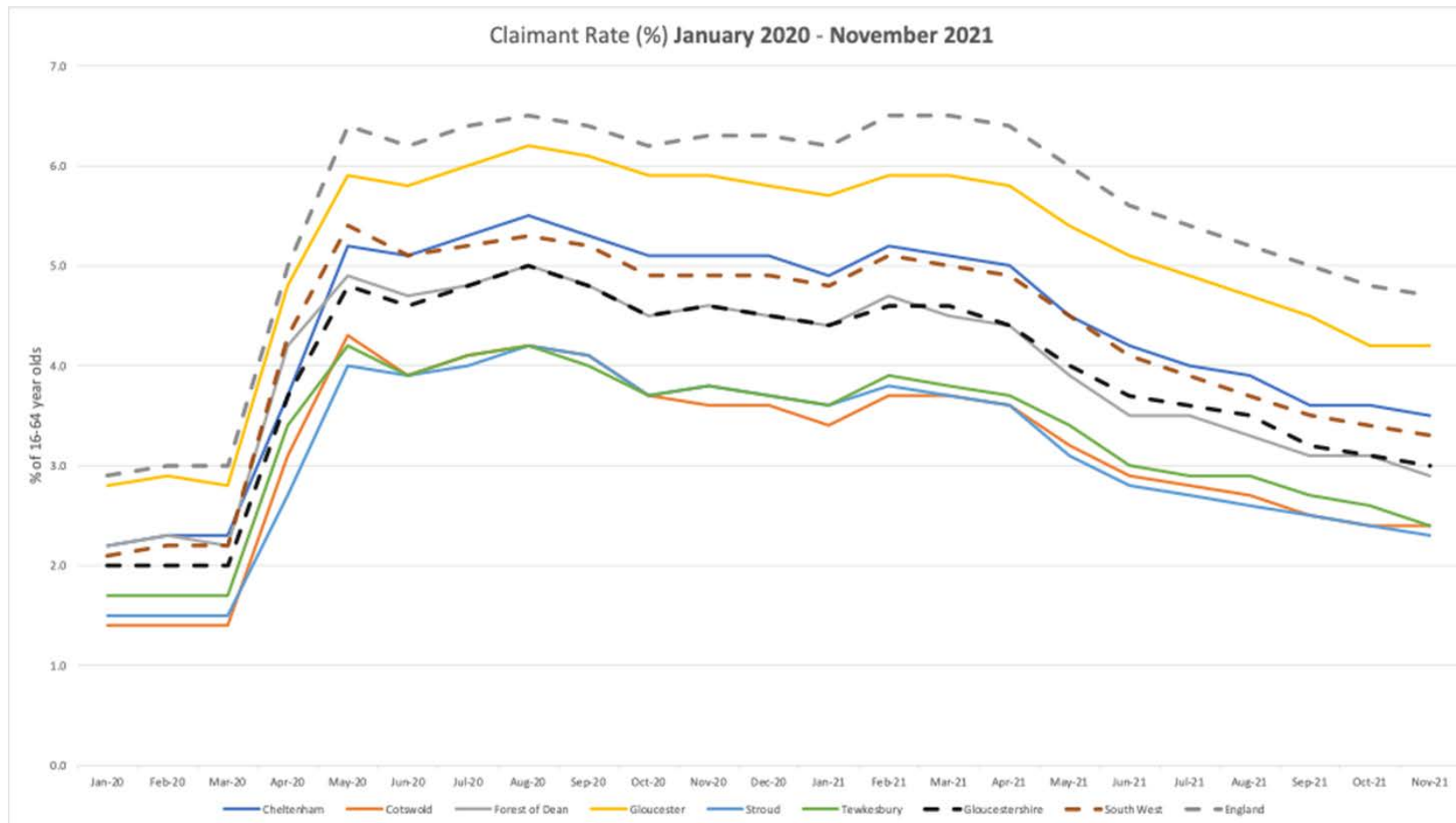


Chart 5: Claimant rate for November 2021 in Gloucestershire compared with South West and UK



Furloughed employments



- The following furlough statistics are **final** for the month of September and based on the latest available information from HMRC, which includes claims made by the 21st November 2021.
- Figures show the total number of **employments furloughed in Gloucestershire** as at the **30th September** was **8,500** and this figure has not changed for Gloucestershire from the provisional release in November.
- Also updated this month were the **cumulative number of jobs furloughed** since the start of the scheme in March 2020, which has now seen a cumulative total of **113,500** Gloucestershire employments supported by the CJRS at various times.
- Chart 6 below shows the district breakdown of workers furloughed at the end of September 2021.

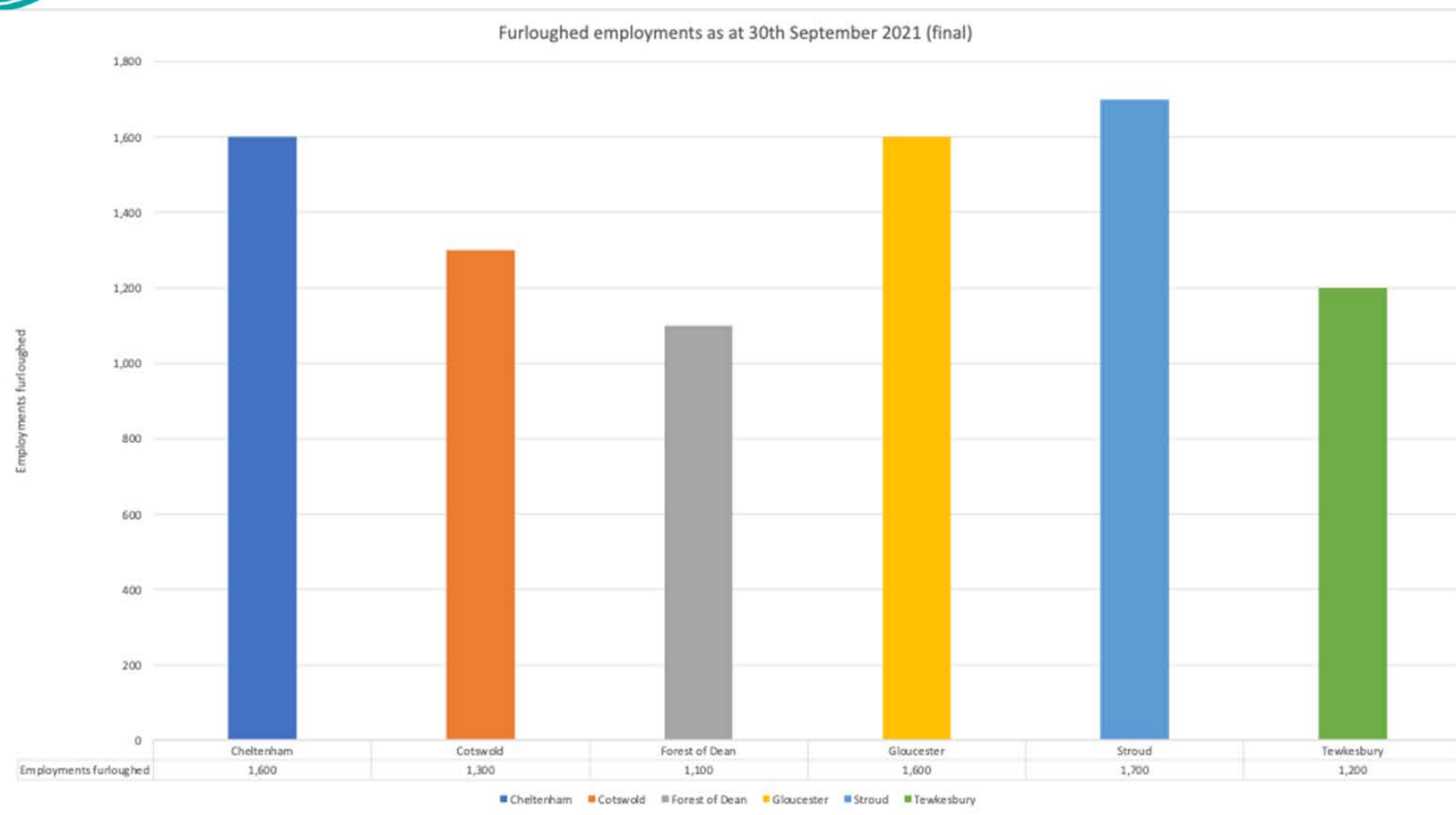

- Chart 7 below shows the total number of furloughed employments in Gloucestershire at the 30th September by broad age group, alongside totals for each of these broad age groups. The age groups with the largest number of furloughed employments were 50 to 54 (1,110) and 55 to 59 (1,100) and 45 to 49 (1,000)

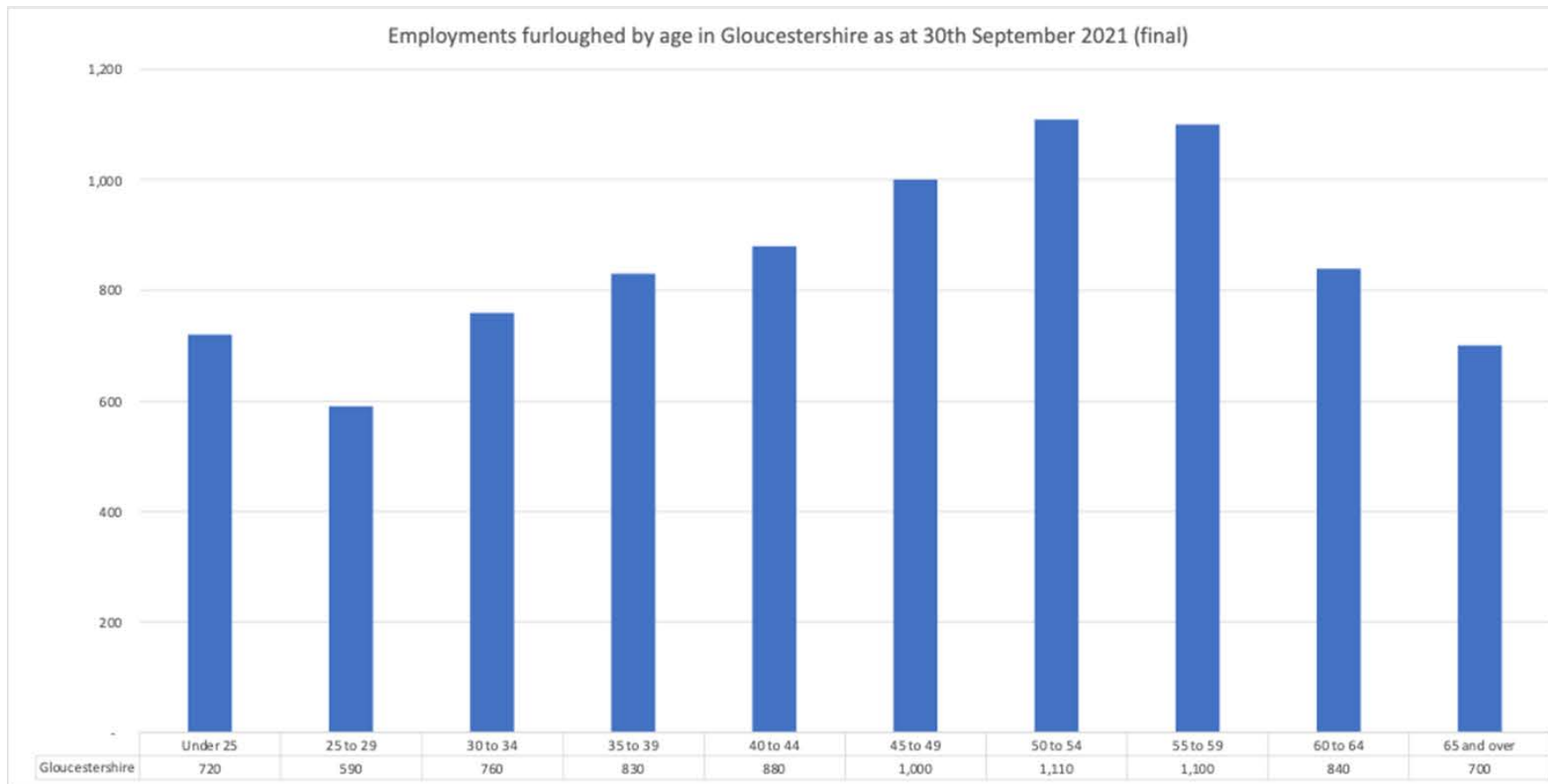

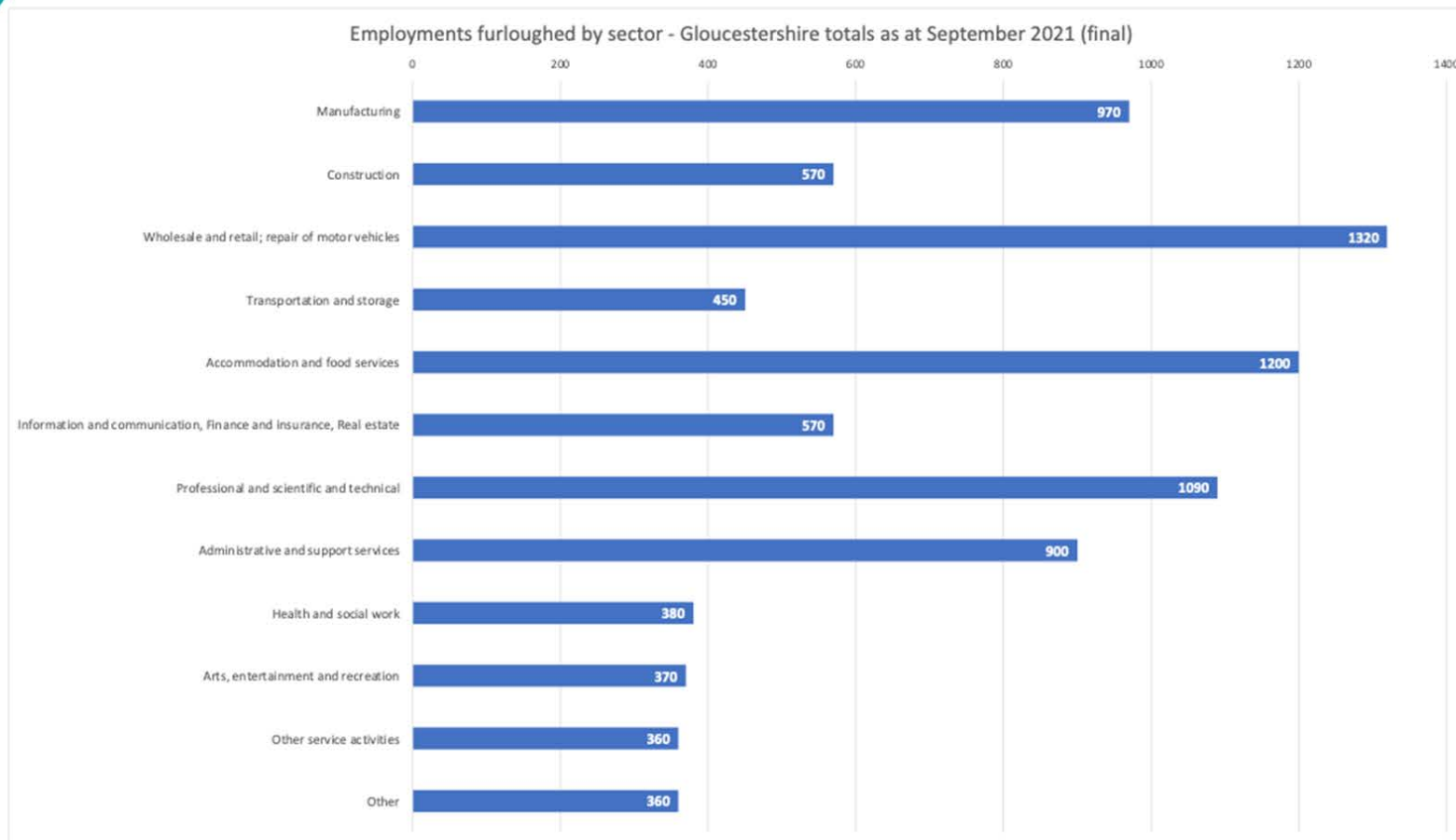

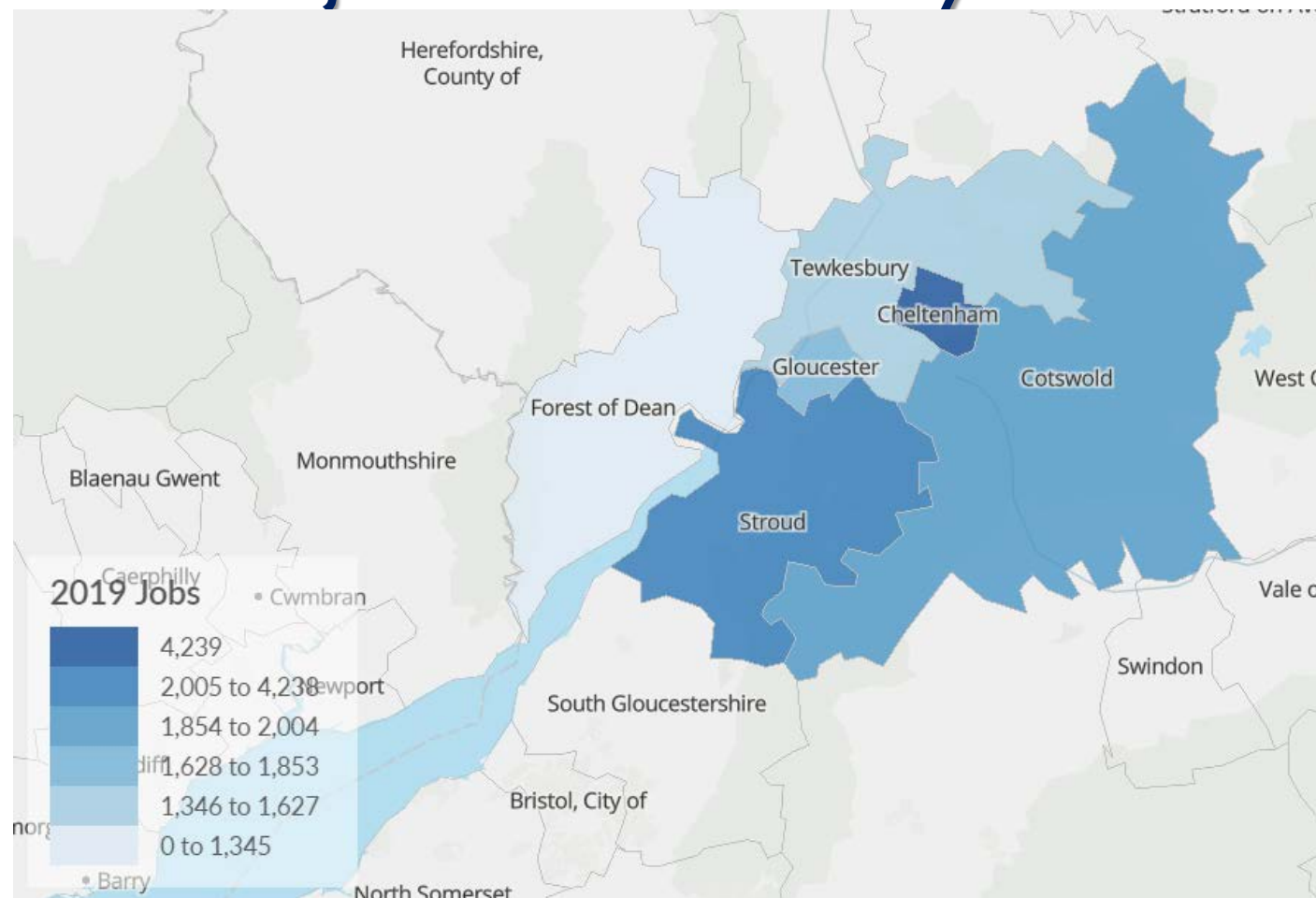
